











Step 2. Have your ACAT assessment at home

You will be contacted by the ACAT to arrange to visit you and work out the amount of help you may need.

Step 3. Complete an Income Assessment with Department of Human Services (DHS)

Step 4. Wait for three letters

- 1. ACAT letter approving your care level.
- 2. DHS letter with your income assessment.
- 3. Home Care Package Assignment letter
 - this may take 6 to 12 months.

Step 5. Got all the letters? Get moving!

You have 56 days to organise your services.

Step 6. Compare service providers

With your letters in hand – call your preferred providers to compare services and costs, and hopefully we're one of them.

Step 7. Select a service provider and sign up

Your services can start immediately.

Public Trustee celebrates Seniors Week



PUBLIC Trustee WA will be hosting free community talks regarding the importance of wills, planning ahead and getting your affairs in order during Seniors Week again this year

Hosted by WA's best known public speaker on

wills, and director at the Public Trustee, Etta Palumbo, the talks will provide advice and understanding around making and safely storing your will, how to navigate the deceased estate administrative process, benefits and risks of Enduring Powers of Attorney (EPA) and Guardianship (EPG), safeguarding against financial or elder abuse in later life and more.

"We're really looking forward to celebrating Seniors Week again this year and we encourage everyone to come along and learn more about planning for the later stages of life and the services and support available to seniors and the wider public," said Ms Palumbo.

"These events have proven very popular in previous years with venues booking up quickly so we encourage people to book early to avoid disappointment," she said.

Thousands of people die each year without having made their wills and in many cases, the state will benefit while their families and friends lose out. According to research conducted by the Public Trustee, 49 per cent of West Australians have never made a will and a further 34 per cent of the local population acknowledge that their will is not up-to-date.

"Writing a will and being prepared can be easy
and cost-effective compared to dying intestate
and, at the Public Trustee,
we want to ensure that all
West Australians have
access to information
and services to help them
through the process" said
Ms Palumbo.

For anyone who has been thinking about updating or making a new will or EPA, WA Seniors Week is the best time to get informed and tick it off the to-do-list.
